> You should probably make them aware of Calif.Penal Code section
> 422: "Any person who wilfully threatens to commit a crime which will
> result in death or great bodily injury to another person, with the
> specific intent that the statement, made verbally, in writing, or by
> means of an electronic communication device, is to be taken as a
> threat, even if there is no intent of actually carrying it out,
> which, on its face and under the circumstances in which it is made,
> is so unequivocal, unconditional, immediate, and specific as to
> convey to the person threatened, a gravity of purpose and an
> immediate prospect of execution of the threat, and thereby causes
> that person reasonably to be in sustained fear for his or her own
> safety or for his or her immediate family's safety, shall be
> punished by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed one year
> or by imprisonment in the state prison (for 16 months, 2 years or 3
> years)."

> The electronic communication device specifically includes phone,
> email and fax; great bodily injury is a factual finding, but usually
> means "significant or substantial physical injury." There are quite
> a few prosecutions under this statute, so there are many caselaw
> fine points; it IS clear that the statute means what it says about
> I-wasn't-really-serious is NOT a defense.
