
We are attorneys for Stephanie Adams. We have been informed by our client that, for some time, you have had postings on your personal website concerning Ms. Adams. Many of the statements on your website are false, libelous and defamatory and violate various statutory provisions and common law rights. Among other things, your website refers to and quotes emails which you allege are from Ms. Adams. Ms. Adams has advised us that she did not send those emails, a fact you should know because you claim to be able to trace the sender.

You are hereby notified that you must remove the "Stephanie Adams" pages from your website. If you do not do so, you will be sued.

We understand that you previously received a demand letter from Ms. Adams' prior attorney, but you ignored that letter and all other requests that you remove the "Stephanie Adams" pages. Your response to that prior lawyer's letter on your website demonstrates that you will not remove the offensive web pages unless a Court orders you to do so. If you fail to remove the pages, Ms. Adams has authorized us to commence legal action against you. We believe that Ms. Adams has sound legal grounds to sue you, and she will hold you liable for compensatory and punitive damages and obtain an injunction and other equitable relief against you.

If the "Stephanie Adams" pages are not removed by May 31, 2006, we will take such actions as are appropriate. Please guide your actions accordingly.
